

Identification brake discs / brake drums

Since entry into force of Supplement 06 to the 11 Series of amendments to Directive ECE R13, it is necessary to identify original parts from the original equipment manufacturer. Therefore the Directive ECE R13 introduced "identification codes". These codes are noted in the documentation and approval documents of the brake system.

The following table shows the corresponding identification codes for brake drums and brake discs. The identification is made by the different brake sizes.

brake drums

| <i>brakesize</i> | <i>identification code</i> |
|------------------|----------------------------|
| 17,5" | gigant T175-XXX |
| 19,5" | gigant T195-XXX |
| 22,5" | gigant T225-XXX |

brake discs

| <i>brakesize</i> | <i>identification code</i> |
|------------------|----------------------------|
| 17,5" | gigant S175-XXX |
| 19,5" | gigant S195-XXX |
| 22,5" | gigant S225-XXX |

Table 2: Identification brake disc

In future, this "identification code" is also added to the "information documents" for the test reports for brakes, according to ECE R13 Annex 11.

„x“: The different numbers which are characterized with an "x" are representing versions of the tested type, whose modifications have no influence on the function and effect regarding the tests carried out.
